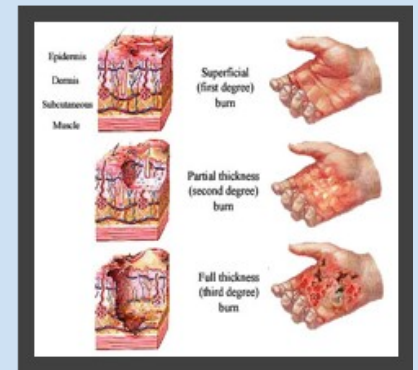
Burns - Patient Assessment, and Treatment
