1. BLS Treatment

- 1.1. Routine Medical Care – Adult (700-S04) or Pediatric (700-S05)
 - 1.1.1. **Titrate oxygen as appropriate**
- 1.2. Treat for signs and symptom of shock as necessary adult (700-A10) or Pediatric (700-P09)
 - 1.2.1. Place patient in a position that decreases work of breathing

2. BLS Optional Scope Treatment (Adult)

- 2.1. Adult Anaphylaxis (Respiratory distress, difficulty swallowing, tightness to chest or throat)
 - 2.1.1. **Administer epinephrine auto injector device** per the manufacturer's specifications.

3. BLS Optional Scope Treatment (Pediatric)

- 3.1. Pediatric Anaphylaxis (Respiratory distress, difficulty swallowing, tightness to chest or throat)
 - 3.1.1. **Administer pediatric epinephrine auto injector device** per the manufacturer's specifications.
